



- Participation on a field tour of Greening Project of DTI to promote environmental awareness on the day to day processes of our business;




- Commissioning of LKBP Hymn to instill thru lyrics and music the coop noble mission.






### **INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT**

**To the Board of Directors and General Assembly of

#### **Report on the Audit of the Financial Statements**

##### **Opinion**

I have audited the accompanying financial statements of **LIGAS KOOPERATIBA NG BAYAN SA PAGPAPAUNLAD**, which comprise the statements of financial condition as at December 31, 2019 and 2018, and the statements of operations, statements of changes in equity and statements of cash flows for the years then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In my opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of **LIGAS KOOPERATIBA NG BAYAN SA PAGPAPAUNLAD** as at December 31, 2019 and 2018, and of its financial performance and its cash flows for the years then ended in accordance with Philippine Financial Reporting Frameworks for Cooperatives.

##### **Basis for Opinion**

I conducted my audits in accordance with *Philippine Standards on Auditing (PSAs)* and the *Standard Audit System for Cooperatives (SASC)*. My responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of my report. I am independent of the Cooperative in accordance with the *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants in the Philippines*, and I have fulfilled my other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my opinion.

##### **Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements**

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the Philippine Financial Reporting Framework for Cooperatives, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Cooperative's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Cooperative or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Cooperative's financial reporting process.

##### **Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements**

My objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with PSAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. My conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of my auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Cooperative to cease to continue as a going concern.

I communicate with those charged with governance, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that I identify during my audit.

My audit was conducted for the purpose of forming an opinion on the basic financial statements taken as a whole. # The Birth of LKBP



## OUR HISTORY

Ligas Kooperatiba ng Bayan sa Pagpapaunlad (LKBP), formerly Ligas Kilusang Bayan sa Pagpapaunlad, Inc. (LKBPI), was born on March 02, 1986 right after the historic EDSA Revolution. It originated from Barangay Ligas of then Malolos (now City of Malolos), Bulacan whose founding directors and members, mostly small businessmen and farmers, lamented the sorry state of the victims of loan sharks in their barangay. The thirty (30) founders gathered a starting capital of ₱15,800.00 which was initially lent to members for their livelihood and providential needs at very low interest rate, thus preventing them from borrowing from the so called "bumbay" or "5-6" proliferating then in the place. From here started the continuous growth in membership, capitalization and resources of LKBP. The cooperative has since established a positive image in the sector as proven by various awards and citations it received from various institutions.

The organization was first registered as a credit cooperative in 1989, then it amended its articles of incorporation and By-Laws in 1994 to reflect its shift from credit to multi-purpose cooperative. From mere lending, the cooperative has diversified its businesses and has expanded its areas of operations through its various branch offices, offering variety of programs and services to its members and to communities where it operates. Lately, in preparation for the implementation of the new Manual of Rules and Regulations (MORR) and to strengthen more and expand its financial base and resources, it further amended its Articles of Cooperation and By-Laws. The latest amendment was approved by the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) last September 4, 2012 under Reg. No. 9520-A-No. 2012-09-412. LKBP is now ready to brace up for bigger challenges ahead as it equips itself to giving flesh to its new vision, mission and goals leading to a higher quality of life for members and communities.

Given an authority to operate nationwide LKBP now has ten (10) branches across Region III - six (6) branches are located in Bulacan, two (2) in Bataan, one (1) in Nueva Ecija, and one (1) in Pampanga. The NCR branches are included in the plan and also to expand far in Southern Tagalog region. The Corporate Office is located in the middle vicinity of Barangay Ligas in the City of Malolos, Bulacan, an agrarian-based barangay but now progressing. The office deals with important tasks such as strategic planning, corporate communications, marketing, finance, human resources, information technology, taxes and law. It takes responsibility for the overall success of the cooperative and ensure governance. The branch offices and subsidiaries handle the actual operation of the cooperative. Programs and services includes savings and loans, tulungan program, health care, school, foundation, skills training and manpower placement, coop assurance center, training center, memorial lots, construction supplies and general merchandise, business center, assets management, agri-ventures, resort and multi-purpose activity center.

All the success of LKBP are owed to people behind it, the men and women at the helm. Seven (7) dedicated persons serve as Board of Directors of LKBP supported by various committees. It employs more than hundred employees, teachers and officers across all branches, units and subsidiaries. It is a government arm on employment endeavor with indisputable contribution to the economy. It serves its advocacy as a friendly Cooperative who shares success and experiences to other Cooperatives and other sectors who pay visit through Lakbay-Aral where Filipinos and foreign visitors are cordially welcome being partners along the road of cooperativism.

Prestigious awards and citations from Land Bank of the Philippines (LBP), Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), National Confederation of Cooperatives (NATCCO), National Livelihood Development Corporation (NLDC), Network Consolidated Cooperative Bank (NCCB), Provincial Government of Bulacan, Philippine Red Cross-Bulacan Chapter, and other government and non-government institutions has made LKBP on top. The LBP is very proud to recognize LKBP as their Gawad Pitak Awardee in the year 2007-2008, a Hall of Fame Awardee in 2009, a Ginintuang Gawad Pitak Awardee in 2011, and entry in the Platinum Gawad Pitak Award. The CDA recognized LKBP in the Gawad Parangal as Most Outstanding Cooperative in Large Scale Regional Search in the year 2015 upon reaching the vision of becoming a billionaire cooperative. The NLDC recognized LKBP as Development Partner in 2007-2009 as well as Recipient of "Sipag Awards" Plaque of Recognition, and as Most Outstanding Cooperative for Luzon in the year 2010. The Bulacan Provincial Government also recognized LKBP as its Hall of Fame Awardee for "Natatanging Kooperatiba sa Bulakan", and the Regional Cooperative Development Council as Most Prolific Cooperative. It was given recognition by the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) as Top Performing ARBO's Information Technology-Enabled Maturity Assessment (ITEMA) for the year 2016 up to 2018. Recently, the City of Malolos Cooperative Development Council (CMCDC) recognized LKBP as a Continuing Excellence Billionaire Cooperative awardee.

The LKBP accreditations and affiliations create strong partnership with various Regional/Provincial/City/Municipal Cooperative Development Councils, Bulacan Cooperatives Hall of Fame League (BCHOFL), Bulacan Federation of Cooperatives (BUFECO), Landbank Countryside Development Foundation, Inc. (LCDFI), Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP), United Coconut Planters Bank (UCPB), Coop-NATCCO Party list, Asian Women in Cooperative Development Forum (ACWF), Small Business Corporation (SBC), Metro South Cooperative Bank (MSCB), Coop Life Insurance and Mutual Benefit Services (CLIMBS), People Management Association of the Philippines (PMAP)-Bulacan, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Department of Education (DepEd), Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), Department of Agriculture (DA), Department of Tourism (DOT), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), Regional Development Council-National Economic and Development Authority (RDC-NEDA)-Region III, and ACCESS Advisory/International Fund for Agrarian Development (IFAD), Civil Society Organization-Department of Interior and Local Government (CSO-DILG), and many others.

The survival of LKBP is equipped by best practices instituted in the cooperative, among which are - sustained and continuing "Integrated Transformation Program" towards becoming a "World-Class Cooperative"; holistic approach and continuing innovations in serving the needs of members and the communities towards a higher quality of life; sustained investments in long-term goal social enterprises/programs; deepening involvement in the agri sector and rural enterprises for greater countryside development; sustained build-up of internally generated funds towards self-sufficiency and better leveraging for external borrowings; strategic alliances and convergence of support from various GFIs/agencies/NGOs, maximizing resources to implement major programs for the marginalized groups/sectors; benchmarking and sharing experiences and best practices with other coops/organizations, and promoting the ideals of the cooperative movement as a better-way of life towards progress and development; modelling a 5-year "Total Community Development Plan" through launching of Agrarian Reform Community (ARC) in Barangay Ligas comprising of 7 identified poor farming barangays in the City of Malolos, in partnership with DAR and various support agencies, to pioneer a "Model ARC within a City"; and development of new Medium-Term Development Plan for CY 2016-2020, sustaining the gains of CY 2011-2015 Medium-Term Development Plan in furtherance of LKBP's expanding and more holistic new Vision, Mission, and Goals.
